






Vista Research Network Feeling Good at Six Months Post-Treatment




Abstinence Six Months Post-Treatment



Abstinence Rate Trends Vista Research Network-Moderate to Severe SUD














Overall Feeling by Length of Stay

At Twelve Months Post-Treatment




Twelve Months Post-Treatment Outcomes by Addiction Severity Vista Research Network




Actions Taken For At Least Six Months Post-Treatment That May Or May Not Have Helped Patients Feel Better at Twelve Months








Patient Progress on Depression Symptoms




Patient Progress on Anxiety Symptoms



Patient Progress on Trauma Symptoms




Patient Progress on Mania Symptoms




Patient Progress on Psychosis Symptoms



Patient Progress on Functioning




Patient Progress on Overall Feeling




Impact of Treatment on Employment

Employment at Intake


Employment at Twelve Month




% Charged with Serious Criminal Justice Offense


